Agility/Obedience Class Fee Structure

- Class fees are \$20 per class IF paid in advance for the entire month. Classes cancelled due to bad weather or holidays will be credited.
- Class payments are due the **first class of the month.**
- Cost for 5-week Beginning Session is \$125 to be paid at the time of enrollment
- Class fee is \$25 per class for drop-in's OR if you will not be paying the entire month in advance. (No drop-in's will be permitted without prior permission from the DrivenDogs office. No Exceptions.)
- The \$20 per class rate is a discount rate for monthly students.

Effective January 1st, 2012: Group Classes are \$20 per classes for monthly students. Class fees are to be paid on the first class of the month. Students are welcome to drop into classes, with permission. Drop ins are \$25 per class. DrivenDogs does offer a discounted rate to students attending two (2) or more classes per week. The discounted rate will be \$15 per class on the second and subsequent classes (applied to which ever class has fewer class meetings that month).

DrivenDogs Agility Make-Up Class Policy

There will be no make up classes or credits for missed classes during Monthly Classes or a 5-Week Beginning Class Session. If a student is going to be absent for a prolonged period of time, they can elect to pay the monthly class fee in order to hold their place in that class, or forfeit their place in the class. If a student elects to forfeit their place in a class, there may not be room for them in that class when they want to return.

In the event DrivenDogs Agility cancels a pre-paid group class for any reason, (ie: holidays, rain, bad weather, emergency, trainer illness, etc...), you will be credited for the cancelled class.

PLEASE EMAIL THE OFFICE FOR INFORMATION ON CLASS SCHEDULES IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER OR HOLIDAYS.

It is recommended that you call the office or check your email, if the weather looks iffy. There are occasions where we may have to cancel class with very little notice, so it is advisable that you always check you email before coming to class. We don't want you showing up if classes are cancelled! If classes are unable to be held, DrivenDogs Agility will note it in the attendance roster and you will be credited for the cancelled class the following month.

DrivenDogs Training Facility General Rules

1. The speed limit is 5mph at all times when at the DrivenDogs Training Facility.
2. Pick up your dog's poop. In the event you see a dog poop that isn't yours, please pick it up and help up keep the DrivenDogs Facility clean!
3. Potty your dog outside the fenced training area, before entering the fenced training field.
4. All dogs must be on leash, unless they are within the fenced training area.
5. Do not allow your dog to pee on anything man-made. This includes (but is not limited to): gates, fencing, trash cans, etc... If your dog does urinate on anything man-made, rinse it off with water.

Beginning Agility/Obedience Session: First Class Information

Things to bring:

- 4-6 foot leash
- Flat buckle type collar or martingale collar
- Water and bowl for your dog
- Water or soda for yourself
- Comfortable running shoes
- Dog Potty Bags for Clean-Up
- Your dog's favorite treats (**Recommend:** soft type treats such as hot dog, string cheese, Natural Balance Rolls, Solid Gold treats, etc) and toys
- A hungry dog (**Recommend:** Do not feed your dog their evening meal; it's easier to keep them focused if they are a bit hungry)

If you have not mailed them in, please bring:

- Completed and signed the Class Application and Liability Form
- Cash, check, or money order made payable to DrivenDogs Agility for \$125.

We believe that dog training must be fun for both the dog and the handler therefore we strive to make sure that each step of training is fun. When you arrive at the training site, please wait outside the training area until your instructor lets you know it is okay to enter. Please **DO NOT** allow your dog on any of the equipment until your instructor has given you permission. Also, PLEASE remember to clean up after yourself and your dog.
